

Think your phone is safe in 2019? Think again.



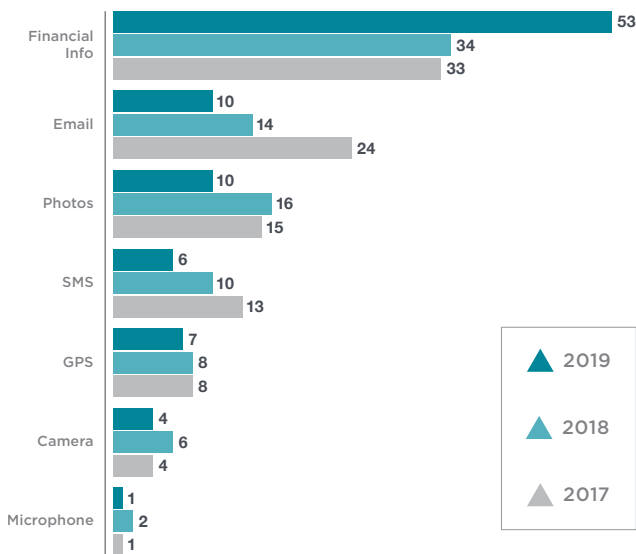
of survey respondents don't know if their phone has been hacked - down slightly from 2018 but still much higher than the 12% reported in 2017.

are aware that their phone is not safe in airplane mode - no change from 2017 or 2018.

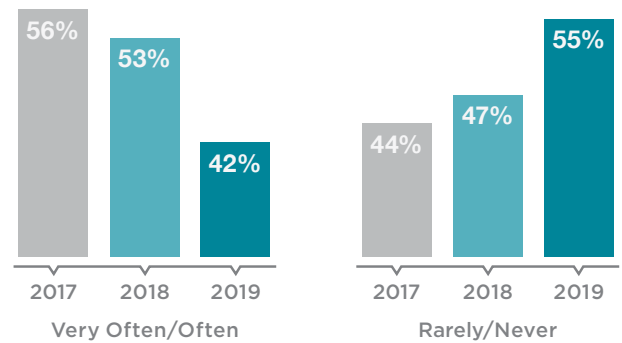
While concern over financial information grows, fewer understand the risks associated with cameras and microphones.

What is your biggest concern if your phone were hacked?



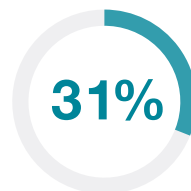
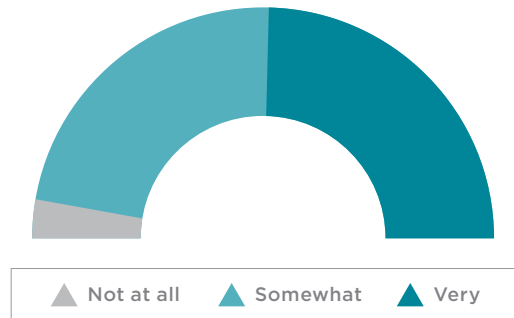
People are becoming more careful about their conversations.
